Why should I take part?

Your experiences and views matter. By joining a group discussion, you can help us understand how living with young-onset dementia is shaped by different aspects of your life, such as your experiences with healthcare, work and your identity. What you share will improve understanding and inform more appropriate support and services.

Am I eligible to take part?

- You are eligible if you are a person living with dementia and were diagnosed before your 65th birthday.

What will it involve?

- A focus group discussion with three other people living with young onset dementia – either online or in person.
- The focus group will take one hour.
